

Who Can Play on Your Membership?

If you have an Individual Full Stock Membership, only you are entitled to full club privileges. If you have paid the additional fee to add Family to your membership, you and your spouse or significant other (see below), and any of your children who have not attained the age of 24 **and** who reside in your home are also entitled to full club privileges. Junior Members and their spouses, significant others, and children have full club privileges. If you have children 12 years old and younger, please note that they are not allowed on the golf course unless they are supervised by an adult.

Significant Other Policy

Non-married members can declare one qualified significant other who resides exclusively in the same domicile as the member during April-October of the current golf season. The qualified significant other is then entitled to all the rights, benefits and privileges of membership, including participation in leagues, tournaments, and championships.

Club Accounts

You will receive only one invoice for your yearly dues and amenities (cart usage fee, cart storage, GAM/GHIN, etc.). Therefore, it is your responsibility to keep your account paid up to date. All delinquent accounts are subject to service charges and Board action if not kept current. If pay your dues in full by February 1st you will receive ½ green fee rates for your guests. You may choose to pay your dues monthly, but all amenities (cart usage fee, cart storage, GAM/GHIN, etc.) **must** be paid in full by April 1st.

Kitchen Minimum

Each membership is required to satisfy a food minimum in the dining room between January 1st and December 31st. Every time you order, the server will ask you for your membership number. The server will record this on your bill. A running total will be kept throughout the season. If you do not spend the required amount, you will be billed for the remainder at the end of the year. Any beverage purchase you make will also count toward your minimum. You are prohibited from using another member's membership number.

Dress Code

We do have a dress code here at Clio Country Club. All members and guests must be fully attired at all times while on the premises. All clothing worn must conform to the styles offered in the golf shop. All members and guests must wear a golf-style shirt – collared shirt or mock. Jeans are allowed. Please dress your guests as you would dress yourself. The following are **NOT** acceptable: ripped or torn jeans, bib overalls, spandex, cut-offs, tank-tops, tee-shirts, halter or spaghetti strap tops. Please have a sense of pride about your club.

Private Golf Carts

One of the privileges of being a member at Clio Country Club is the opportunity to use your own golf cart. There will be a yearly "trail fee" assessed to members who use their own cart. If you wish to store your cart on site, there will be a yearly cart storage fee assessed. If you choose to store on site, you must sign a cart barn waiver before bringing your cart to the golf course. You will receive an assigned cart barn number and space and must use that space only. If you are not storing your golf cart on site, you may trailer it in every time you use it. If you choose this option, you must take your cart with you when you leave. Carts that have been trailered in cannot be left on the premises.

Who Can Drive Your Golf Cart?

If you have your own golf cart, only you and the persons playing on your membership may use the cart. Your cart **CANNOT** be loaned out to any other member or individual. If you have children, please be aware that your child must be 16 years or older to drive a golf cart unsupervised. If your child is between the ages of 12 and 15, he or she may drive the cart only if in direct visual supervision of an adult. If your child is less than 12 years of age, he or she is strictly prohibited from driving a golf cart anywhere on the premises.

Open Play

Clio Country Club does not have tee times for open play. Once you get to the course, all you have to do is sign the register in the golf shop. It is important that you sign the register every time you play golf so that if an emergency arises, we will know where to quickly find you.

All play is off the 1st tee. Please note that there is no starting on the 10th tee without permission from the golf shop.

Occasionally, we will have tournaments or outside outings scheduled at the golf course. Check the website, bulletin boards, or call the golf shop to see when these events are scheduled.

Guest Play

You are always welcome to bring guests out to play. When you register for golf in the golf shop, sign in both you and your guest(s). When bringing guests, please note that you can bring the same individual only 5 times between the months of May and September.

Winter Play

The golf shop operates from April 1st – October 31st. If the golf season is extended by nice weather, the golf course itself will still be open if course conditions permit.

We do offer a reduced green fee for these winter months.

When you bring a guest out between November 1st and March 31st, please pay in the office.

Tournament Play

Clio Country Club has a very active tournament schedule. There are numerous tournaments for men, women, and couples held on the weekends throughout the summer. The women also have a separate tournament schedule that plays events on certain Tuesdays and Thursdays. Dates for all these tournaments are posted outside the golf shop and on the website.

If you would like to play in a tournament, just inform one of the golf shop staff members. He or she will show you where the sign-up sheets are posted. We encourage you to play in as many tournaments as possible. It is a great way to meet new people.

**To play in a tournament, you must have an established handicap. Anyone who has paid for a handicap is already in the handicap computer. When you are ready to post a score for the first time, tell one of the staff members in the golf shop. He or she will walk you through the process. You must have at least five (5) 18-hole rounds posted to establish a handicap.*

Junior Golf

The Junior Golf program here at Clio Country Club has been very popular over the years. The program consists of instruction and play dates throughout the summer. Our program is currently open to members and non-members. Registration forms are typically available in the middle of May.

Kings & Queens

Kings and Queens is a very popular couple event here at Clio Country Club. It's a great way to meet and get to know current members. These events take place on designated Fridays during the months of May through September. Each event has a "theme" and players are encouraged to dress for the occasion. The golf formats are alternate shot and scrambles and each event is designed for players of all skill levels. The emphasis is always on fun. If you don't have anyone to play with, the golf shop will be happy to set you up with a group.

Social Activities

Clio Country Club has a very active social calendar. The Social Committee plans and coordinates the social activities and parties throughout the summer and winter months. These events are a lot of fun and a great way to meet new people. Watch your weekly email and the clubhouse bulletin boards for all the events.

Driving Range

You can purchase bags of range balls individually, but you may also choose to take advantage of one of our money saving plans. Seasonal membership rates are available for an individual, couple, or family. Driving range punch cards are also available to help lower your cost per bag.

The CCC golf shop is available for all your needs. A full line of golf balls, shoes, apparel, and equipment is available from golf's leading manufacturers.
